The Fairbanks Family in America (FFA) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization organized for the purpose of owning, maintaining and preserving the Old House, gathering and studying collections related to the Fairbanks Family, and educating our membership and the general public about the history of the Fairbanks family. The Fairbanks House in Dedham, MA is the oldest surviving timber frame house in North America. Built ca. 1637 for Jonathan and Grace Fairbanks, the house was inhabited by eight generation of Fairbanks family members until 1904 when it was purchased by the Association. The House is open for public tours from May through October. The FFA is largely supported by the generosity of our members and patrons.
